

Riders start randomly at 30-second intervals. Come to the line as soon as you are ready.

Special Notes: Warm up on course allowed until 8:15. Otherwise use H-313 (Algodones/San Felipe Pueblo the west frontage road) or a stationary trainer. Approved helmets must be worn at all times while on your bike.

Online entry fee \$25/ race. Online entry closes Friday 10 p.m. prior to race.

Same-day registration at race, 8:00 - 8:30 a.m., is \$30/day. No entry fee for juniors with USAC license. No extra charge for multiple rides on same day. To race you must have an USAC license, either annual or one-day. One-day licenses will be available for \$15. Annual licenses available for purchase

ON Site. Rule 1A3(c) One-day Beginner Licenses may only be purchased by the lowest category rider for that discipline. No rider may purchase a one-day beginner license if he or she has ever held an annual license with a category higher than category 5 men or category 4 women for road, track or cyclo-cross.
