If you race twice in one day, you get \$10 off your second registration.

Registration after March 26 at 10:00 pm for Non-Collegiate Categories – Entry Fee, Plus \$5

Day of Registration for Non-Collegiate Categories – Entry Fee, Plus \$10

Day of registration will take place at the registration tent near the start (excludes collegiate events). We will open at 7:00 am and close 40 minutes before the start of each category, Entry fee includes USAC Surcharges.

Rules

All USAC Rules apply including junior gear and bike restrictions.

Circuit Race: Centerline Rule, Feed Zone (available for races longer than 45 mi) and discard zones in effect. **No support on the road – Bring spare & pump**. However, there will be a wheel pit at the finish line – Wheels in, wheels out.

There will be NO PARKING AT THE START FINISH/ALONG THE FEED ZONE. Park along Country Road 56 (the dirt) past where the race enters the hills community if you are feeding. You will have to ride back to the start.

Please PICK UP YOUR TRASH/PUT WRAPPERS IN YOUR POCKET. The Hills community is very receptive of our race, but they ask we leave no trash and do not damage their grass.

Criterium: Free lap rule in effect until 5 laps to go in each field. Wheel pit at start - Wheels in, wheels out.


License and Membership

USAC races: USAC license required. USAC 1-day license is \$10, only for Cat 5 men and women. BRAC Annual membership recommended to avoid BRAC 1-day membership fee (\$5). BRAC membership exempt with USAC 1-Day and out-of-state riders. Annual BRAC membership available at <u>www.coloradocycling.org</u>

Collegiate riders entering non-collegiate races must have a USAC license.

Collegiate Races: USAC Collegiate license required. Annual USAC Collegiate licenses available online at www.usacycling.org/register

Cobb Lake Circuit Race Information:

NOTE: **The Dirt Section is rougher than ordinary pavement. Bring suitable tires!**

Parking and Registration (New start location!)

Event Parking and Registration for Cobb Lake will be at the Budweiser Headquarters just south of the Richards Lake Rd and Busch Drive intersection in the Budweiser Experience parking lot. Please exit I-25 at the Mountain Vista Exit, then head North on Busch Dr. and turn left into the Biergarten lot. GPS Directions: <u>Parking/Registration</u> and <u>Finish Line</u>

Neutral Zone

There will be a neutral start (highlighted in blue) from the green dot (start line) until you turn right a second time, heading north on the frontage road. Racing begins on the frontage road.

Lap Count

Since the start is on the opposite end of the course from the finish (Red Line), when you cross the finish line for the first time, your lap count will begin (Example: if your field races 5 laps, it will actually be 5.5 laps total).

The finish line will be approximately 200 ft lower on the hill than in previous years. This is simply so we can park the timing trailer without damaging the grass.

Parking

To get to parking, Exit I-25 at the Harmony Exit. Take Harmony west until you reach Shields St., then turn right (north) onto Shields. Go north until you reach Drake Rd., then head east (right) until Research Blvd. Turn north on Research and then right into the south parking lot. Parking will be to the south of the course (don't park in the middle of the course as you won't be able to get your car out). Please come from Drake Rd. and not from the north to minimize traffic. Registration

This will be in the parking lot on the inside of the course.

Course Notes

There is a section of bumpy pavement on the course. It's not too bad but be aware. Recommendation is to pre-ride, weight the outside foot, let go of the brakes and "let 'er eat!!!"
