HB211 Redistricting Act has been filed in the House by Representatives Dow, Figueroa, Fajardo and Garratt. We have over fifteen co-sponsors, Republican and Democrat. It is assigned to House State Government, Elections and Indian Affairs Committee (HSEIC). Please *call* and urge the Committee to support the Redistricting Act, HB211. The Senate version of the bill will be filed on Monday by Senators Ortiz y Pino and Moores. We expect it will go to Senate Rules and Senate Judiciary. We will send out an alert once we get a bill number.
