Karen Meyers, Consumer Attorney (retired) and New Mexicans for Fair Lending Coalition

Karen, a consumer protection lawyer and policy advocate for more than 40 years, created and was the Director of the City of Albuquerque's Consumer Financial Protection Initiative from 2019 until 2021. Prior to that she was the Assistant Deputy Enforcement Director for Policy and Strategy at the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB). She has also served as Director and Assistant Attorney General for the Consumer Protection Division, Office of NM Attorney General.

Nicholas Mattison, Partner at Feferman, Warren & Mattison law firm

Nick sues unscrupulous businesses, including predatory lenders, credit reporting agencies, car dealers, banks, door to door sellers, and others. Together with his partners, he brings individual cases and class actions on behalf of consumers. Over the last decade, his work has returned millions of dollars to people around the State of New Mexico. Prior to joining the firm, Mr. Mattison worked for four years in the Window Rock office of DNA-People's Legal Services, and before that, he was an elementary school teacher in Thoreau, New Mexico.
