## TIME TO UPGRADE YOUR SKI GEAR?

OR TO FINALLY GET RID OF THOSE OLD SKIS GATHERING DUST IN YOUR GARAGE?

November is a great time of year to be reviewing your ski set-up(s), getting any needed repairs or tune-ups, and preparing for the upcoming season. Luckily there are numerous options to buy new or used ski gear locally (not to mention online), or to get rid of equipment you no longer need.

## Buying or Renting New Ski Equipment:

Albuquerque Sports Systems: Local retailer carrying new Rossignol cross-country ski equipment (including kids gear!) as well as used skis and equipment. Their full-service ski & snowboard repair shop is already open for the season. They also do rentals & rental packages. More information can be found at their website here.

New Moon Ski & Bike Shop: Located in Hayward, Wisconsin (home of the famed Birkebeiner ski race), New Moon is your online source for all things XC ski. ### Buying or Selling Used Ski Equipment:

Albuquerque Outdoor ReGear: A local outdoor gear-focused consignment shop that sells used clothing and equipment for a range of outdoor sports, including cross-country skiing. Their website is here.
