

**Report of Application of Penofin or Paint on Picnic Tables
or Benches at Six Sites on the Sandia Ranger District on Tuesday, July 27,
2021**

On Tuesday, July 27, 2021, Penofin (Penetrating Oil Finish) or Forest Service brown paint was applied to picnic tables or benches at four sites along the Crest Highway and at two sites near the SRD shop. Natural color Penofin was applied to picnic tables at the following sites: 10K North Trailhead, Horse Trailer Parking Lot, FOSM Guard Station, and Jim Hughes's mobile home. Penofin was applied to two benches at Capulin Spring Bird Log, and the picnic table at the gate to Kiwanis Meadow Road was painted.

Hello everyone. On July 27th, 2021, the FOSM paint crew split into 2 groups & painted several areas. Sam Beard worked alone & his photos show several areas he improved with a new coat of stain or paint where needed. The remaining members concentrated on the Balsam Glade area. The large kiosk at the entrance of the parking lot was completed by removing all the signage and staples and painted forest service brown. Restroom doors(4) were also painted.

We then proceeded to the very large kiosk along the road(# 536) leading to Placitas. With high ladders & much scraping, we removed loose paint & signage prior to painting with FS brown. With only about 5 minutes of finishing, a storm popped up suddenly & we were pelted with large hailstones & heavy rain. It is evident we will return to the kiosk in a few days & go over areas on the kiosk where some of the "new" paint washed off by the heavy rain.
