On Thursday May 12th, after a 20-week winter/spring "break" in Placitas, fourteen FOSM volunteers returned to the East Sandias to continue work on the Wagon Trail extension. SRD Trails Foreman Russell Berman joined periodically, splitting his time between the FOSM crew and the SRD trail crew (clearing corridor to prepare for an AMBA Saturday volunteer work day two days later at the northwest end of the extension, where it will meet the Sulphur Trail). Half of the FOSM crew focused on some finish-work where we left off in December, just south of where the new extension crosses the drainage/social trail in the Sulphur Canyon Picnic Area. Tasks included widening the tread and reducing the angle of the backslope, both of which involved moving a lot of dirt, rocks, roots and stumps. The other half of the crew continued building new tread north of the drainage... which involved moving a lot of dirt, rocks, roots and stumps. Temps were warm in the sun and pleasant in the shade, with a nice not-too-strong breeze.
