On Thursday October 13th eleven FOSM volunteers, accompanied by SRD Trails Foreman Joseph Jaffa-Martinez, hiked in over 2 miles on 10K North to continue work on a realignment that was started last year by the SRD crew. Two SRD crew members cleared corridor ahead along the reroute while the volunteers and Joseph built new tread. Outside of some large rocks and a good deal of deadfall debris, the digging was fairly easy and good progress was made, perhaps 550 ft of new trail built. It was a beautiful fall day, with cool temps, colorful aspens and blue skies.
