On Thursday September 7, fifteen FOSM volunteers worked not far from the Ellis trailhead, building a reroute (pin-flagged by Cibola NF Trails and Wilderness Manager Russell Berman) of the Kiwanis Meadow Trail. The crew encountered plenty of dusty "duff" (layers of organic material), but otherwise work conditions were ideal: flat terrain, a dearth of rocks, cool temps and plenty of shade. Good progress was made. In addition, several crew members used saws to clear corridor along some sections of the realignment. A few more Kiwanis Meadow Trail reroutes remain, for future workdays.
