

FOSM Board Member Duties

The board meets in person once or twice a year to discuss plans and projects. Additionally, a few times a year there can be an online meeting to approve major expenditures supporting Forest Service or Pueblo projects.

There are eight at-large members (non-officer positions). At-large members serve for two years. Four at-large positions expire each year, so on a rotating every-other-year basis, the four at-large members with one year remaining automatically make up the Nominating Committee.

In addition, board members may volunteer to chair or participate in special committees such as:

- Tijeras Pueblo Archaeological Site
- Interpretive Signage and Maps
- Snowshoe Classic
- Adopt-a-Highway
- All-Projects
