PARTY Till You DYE!! - 2017

What do I wear?

Showing off your color will work with just about ANYTHING you wear.

We recommend the brightest white or light grey to show off ALL the colors!

Glasses are MANDATORY!! BRING sun glasses or safety glasses. Dye in your eyes is annoying!!

Dust masks or bandanas are recommended to cut back on breathed in dust. Dust masks will be available at the party for those that would like to use one

Will the dye wash out of my hair?

The dye is made of colored cornstarch and is designed to be washable.

If you have light-colored hair, or if it's expected to be rainy or a particularly humid day, we suggest adding some leave-in conditioner to your hair before the party.

The dry powders supplied may stain hair & clothes, so goers are cautioned not to wear their "Saturday best."

To avoid and/or minimize stain, vigorously shake out all dry excess powder before stepping into a shower, or throwing your clothes in the wash. Once the caked dry colors get wet, it is hard to get out. However, if one can shake as much as possible out while dry, there is a good chance of not having pink hair for the next month.

Those who would rather observe than participate in the throwing of the colors may stay back and watch from a distance, but there is no guarantee you will not get any dye or dust on you!!

Good idea to bring plastic seat covers or towels or old sheets for the drive home.

Be courteous of the school and local businesses and do not leave messes in their bathrooms!! Goers are advised to think twice before going into the middle of the crowd when the colors are first thrown. If you have not been before, or have asthma, being smack in the middle of the crowd can be a challenge!!

There will be an area marked off to put personal possessions.

Bring all the enthusiasm and energy you have to show your Hornet pride!!

APS, HHS, the event staff, or myself will not take any responsibility for anything that gets stained or damaged!!

DO'S:

Pay attention to the instructions of the dye crew and party MC!

Be respectful and take part in any and all ceremonies, honors, and pride speeches!!

Wear clothes that can get dirty. VERY DIRTY!!

Wear sunglasses, safety glasses or goggles to protect your eyes. MANDATORY!!

Wear a dust mask or bandanna over mouth if worried about the dust. SUGGESTED!!

Stay hydrated!! Drink water before and after the event!!

DON'TS:

NO moshing, wrestling, sexual and/or lewd dancing or acts of any kind!

NO crowd surfing!!

NO cussing or outbursts!

NO gang signs or any lewd poses for the cameras!

NO water bottles or beverages on the dye area!

DO NOT take anything or wear anything into the dye area that you do not want to get dye on,

If it goes into the dye area, it will get powder dye on it!!

DO NOT throw colors into people's eyes!

DO NOT wear contacts to a color event! Either take them out or wear goggles!

DO NOT climb onto the stage or any ladders!

- all ladders are for photographers to get up in the air and get AWESOME shots of the party!
