


# **Summer Picnic**

Directions to Picnic site: From Albuquerque: drive east on I-40 to Exit 175 toward Tijeras, NM. Drive south for 9 miles on State Road 337 (aka James McGrane Memorial Highway). Look for the brown Oak Flat - Cibola National Forest sign, on the east side of the road. Turn east onto Oak Flat Road and follow it for 0.39 miles until you reach the entrance on the left side of the road. Follow the directional signs at the entrance to your site.
